## DAY CAMP SCHEDULE 9 A.M. TO 3 P.M.

Arrive, ready for action!
Groom YOUR horse and prepare to ride.

Lunch time, pack a great meal! Swim in the on-site pool.

Swing into action -- head to the barn for horse lovin' chores!

Head home and sleep well!

Campers should arrive at Sandy River promptly at 9 AM and should come dressed to ride, wearing the appropriate riding pants and boots.

Campers will ride in the morning then have lunch. Supervised swimming is scheduled for after lunch then campers will come back to the barn for afternoon chores. Pick up is at 3 PM. Day campers will need to bring their lunch, a change of clothes and their bathing suit and towel. Flip-flops are fine for the pool, but not in the barn areas, close toed shoes or boots are required around the barn.

• SREC BEGINNER DAY CAMP: JUNE 7 - 11

Open only to beginning riders, no experience required, age 8 or older

• SREC PONY CLUB OVERNIGHT CAMP: JUNE 14 - 18

Open to members of Pony Club.

• SREC DAY CAMP 1: JUNE 21 - 25

Open to riders with some experience, age 8 or older

• SREC DAY CAMP 2: JULY 5 - 9

Open to riders with some experience, age 8 or older

• SREC ADULT CAMP 1: JULY 16 - 18

Open to riders with some experience, age 21 or older

• SREC OVERNIGHT CAMP: JULY 19 - 23

This camp is open to riders with some experience

• SREC ADULT CAMP 2: JULY 30 - AUGUST 1

Open to riders with some experience, age 21 or older

• SREC DAY CAMP 3: AUGUST 2 - 6

Open to riders with some experience and June camp participants, age 8 or older

The cost for day camp is \$250 and includes access to a horse, tack, and riding amenities. Snacks and beverages are provided, you pack and bring your lunch. Adult camp is open to riders with some experience, age 21 or older. The cost is \$250, plus \$20/night stabling if needed, plus \$20/night to camp at the farm, if desired. Overnight camp is \$500 and includes instruction, stabling, lodging and meals.
